**AFFIDAVIT OF TUSHARA WEERASOORIYA
(Sworn June 1, 2026)**

I, **TUSHARA WEERASOORIYA**, of the City of Toronto, in the Province of Ontario, **MAKE OATH AND SAY:**

1. I am a lawyer qualified to practice law in the Province of Ontario and a partner with McMillan LLP ("**McMillan**"), lawyers for Richter Inc., in its capacity as monitor of the Applicant (the "**Monitor**") in its proceedings under the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act* ("**CCAA**"). As such, I have knowledge of the matters hereinafter deposed to.
2. On August 6, 2025 this Court made an order (the "**August 6 Order**") approving, among other things, the professional fees and disbursements of McMillan for the period between June 10, 2025 and July 18, 2025, in the amount of \$62,794.26, plus harmonized sales tax of \$8,163.25, for a total of \$70,957.71, as further set out in the affidavit of Tushara Weerasooriya sworn July 28, 2025.
3. This affidavit is made in support of a motion (the "**Motion**") for, among other things, the approval of the fees and disbursements of the Monitor's counsel since July 19, 2025, to April 30, 2026 (the "**Fee Period**"). This affidavit is filed in conjunction with the Factum of the Monitor, to be filed in advance of the hearing on this Motion.
4. The total amount claimed by McMillan for the Fee Period is \$67,916.87 (inclusive of taxes), which includes fees of \$59,984.00.

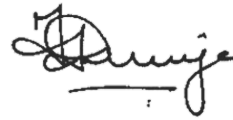
5. The Monitor previously sought and obtained approval of its fees and those of McMillan on a prospective basis for the period from July 19, 2025 to the completion of its mandate (the “**Remaining Period**”). Pursuant to the August 6 Order, the Court approved McMillan’s expected fees for the Remaining Period, estimated at \$30,000.00. That estimate contemplated, among other things, the prompt adjudication of the outstanding WEPPA motion. Subsequently, the WEPPA motion has been adjourned multiple times, leading to more legal work, court attendances and consultations with parties than were contemplated in the court-approved estimate. As a result, McMillan’s fees for the Remaining Period have exceeded the amounts previously approved by the Court.
6. Attached and marked as **Exhibit “A”** to this Affidavit is (i) a schedule summarizing all invoices rendered by McMillan during the Fee Period, including the fees and disbursements, and total fees charged in each invoice (the “**Accounts**”), and (ii) a chart summarizing the respective years of call, hours billed and billing rates of each lawyer at McMillan who acted for the Monitor during the Fee Period.
7. True copies of McMillan’s Accounts for the Fee Period are attached hereto as **Exhibit “B”**.
8. The Accounts and summary charts disclose in detail the name of each person who rendered services, the dates on which the services were rendered, the time spent each day, the rate charged and the total charges for fees, disbursements and taxes.
9. In addition, the Monitor and its counsel will incur some additional fees and disbursements after the Fee Period, including in connection with some ancillary matters that must be completed with respect to this CCAA proceeding. McMillan’s current expectation is that McMillan’s subsequent fees and disbursements will not exceed \$22,000.00 in the aggregate, excluding applicable taxes (the “**Estimated Remaining Fees**”).
10. The hourly billing rates charged in the Accounts and the Estimated Remaining Fees are comparable to the hourly rates charged by McMillan for services rendered in similar proceedings.

11. To the best of my knowledge and given the nature of these proceedings, I believe that the hours and rates in the attached Accounts and the Estimated Remaining Fees are reasonable and comparable to other firms in the applicable centres for work of this nature.

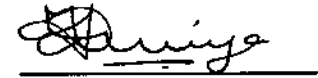

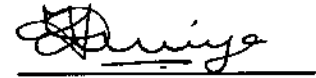

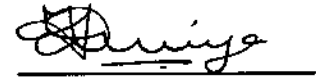
